Dear ADA Schultz,

It appears your understanding of my call to the Harris County District Attorney's Office is wrong. You seem very confused and ignorant about the case. My interest should be the same as the DA's, having the criminals in this case charged and convicted for the crimes they've committed. I thought our interests were the same but now I'm not so sure.

On June 11th you attempted to deceive me by pretending you knew nothing about the case, how can someone who lacks basic honesty enforce the laws of the county? Even after pulling up the case, you said that you knew nothing about the case, you said you were not assigned the case, you said you did not review or reject the case, but you said you would look into it.
