I am responding on behalf of County Attorney Vince Ryan. You have alleged that this Office and the Harris County Sheriff are involved in a conspiracy to cover up corruption. You have alleged that the Office of the County Attorney has filed frivolous briefs with the Texas Attorney General. You have met with Melissa Spinks, Randy Smidt, and Barbara Armstrong, all members of senior management within our office, who have listened to your complaints and answered your questions.

Ms. Spinks, Mr. Smidt, Ms. Armstrong and I have reviewed your allegations and have found no evidence to support your claims.
