This will acknowledge receipt of your correspondence asking this office for assistance in obtaining information you requested from the Harris County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your correspondence was assigned ID# 517298.

The sheriff's office informs us in the enclosed correspondence that it has released all information responsive to your request. When a governmental body represents to this office it has made available all existing responsive information, we must accept its statement. Under the Act, the enforcement authority of the Office of the Attorney General does not include on-site inspections of records held by another governmental office. *See Gov't Code § 552.321.* Accordingly, we will close our file on this matter.
