Dear Ms. Fillion,

Thank you for the courtesy call Thursday Oct 9, 2014 to clear up how IAD Deputy Guerrero reading from his computer, **that Investigator Thomas's narrative conflicts with the audio witness testimony**, was all a mistake.

Thank you for responding to my recent request for IAD interview with Deputy Guerrero on Aug 8, 2014 at IAD HQ when I filed, for the 2nd time, a complaint against Investigator Sgt. Thomas. I have received the 2 statements I signed and the audio of the interview.

You have stated that I have received all IAD Case 12-0081-0305 and/or HC 12-21366 responsive records. However, about 28 minutes into this 4hr interview the audio clearly shows that I have not received all the documents because Deputy Guerrero while reading a Sgt. Thomas report said (my brother) Joe Kenny's testimony stated he did not notice any scratches.

Needless to say this was a surprise to me. I did not know Investigator Thomas ever recorded that I did not have any injuries on any report.

Regardless, I do not have the report Deputy Guerrero was reading from and would like a copy as soon as possible.

Good morning, Susan Fillion,

I am so sorry for submitting a request for data that has already been provided. (Incident Report)
I made a mistake, please accept my apology.

You mentioned sending you any pending PIA requests. I've requested from Ms. Ming additional missing IAD data;

- 1) I believe the IAD report states a video was recorded. This was not included in the Internal Affairs packet I received on August 27, 2013.
- 2) The IAD report concludes with a 'NOT SUSTAINED' without summary/minutes of the meeting when the decision was rendered. Who are the voting members and where is that documentation? There must be more than a letter from Lt. Pair, with Captain Hughes using Lofton Harrison as the acting chief saying 'NOT SUSTAINED', right? This was not included in the Internal Affairs packet I received on August 27, 2013.

One last item; on April 30, 2013 I met with Sgt. Rush at IAD with new evidence showing Sgt. Thomas framed me for participating in crime in order for the original tainted IAD report to maintain its appearance of integrity. I spoke to Sgt. Rush for over 1.5 hours and provided new information along with written and audio sworn testimony. I would have provided testimony that contradicts the sworn testimony of 3 deputies but Sgt. Rush would not accept it. Sgt. Rush did open another IAD investigation in the computer system. Sgt. Rush gave this information to Lt. Pair, who also was involved in the original IAD 'NOT SUSTAINED' cover-up. Sgt. Rush paperwork including narrative along with audio was not included in the Internal Affairs packet I received on August 27, 2013. Would this be considered a new request or a pending request?
