Re: Public Information Act request.

Dear Mr. Kenny:

You have asked for “a copy of the written narrative/summary of the recorded testimony of Bill Kenny, Lisa Kenny, and Joseph Kenny provided by Sgt. Thomas to HCDA ADA Natalie Schultz.”

With respect to this request, I request that you discuss with this office how this request might be clarified pursuant to Section 552.222(b) of the Texas Government Code. Specifically, I request clarification on the following:

- (1) When you reference a “written narrative/summary of the recorded testimony of Bill Kenny, Lisa Kenny, and Joseph Kenny,” it is unclear what you are referring to. Are you referring to the February 14, 2012 incident report for Incident # 12-21366? Are you referring to a different document? I have closely examined the materials related to your complaints to Terese Buess, Mike Anderson, and Belinda Hill, and I have found no documents prepared by Sergeant Thomas. Please clarify.
- (2) When you reference information provided by Sgt. Thomas to Natalie Schultz, when and where would that have taken place? I spoke with Ms. Schultz (who no longer works for the District Attorney’s Office) and read her your request, and she did not remember being provided with anything like what you described. If you provide some context for this request, it may assist in determining what we have, if anything.

Please be advised that under Section 552.222(d) of the Texas Government Code, if by the 61st day after the date this office sent this written request for clarification or discussion under Section 552.222(b), this office or its officer for public information has not received a written response from you, the underlying request for public information will be considered to have been withdrawn by you.
