Monday: Sept. 17, 2012

Sent Ben email saying illogical to report back to lie-in when the evidence could implicate her. Need unbiased eyes outside of Intake.

----- Received call from I believe Clint Greenwood – saying he was the boss and he directed their training. He gave me till Wed pm ----

Friday: Oct. 5 (R85)

Talk to David Chou with Texas Consumer Complaint Center (law students Ch13 Atty) after seeing a report on TV and contacting them earlier in the week.

They can't help.

Call 911 attempt to find out if my recording is legit – no help.

Send Cert Letter to Chow – make decision.

Call from Leslie HCAO pia **(R90)** – they have received request, have 10 days to submit to AG? I said you are going to submit it to the AG for a ruling – that's their procedure. Leslie said the attorney is Cheryl Thornton 713-274-5146.

Sent Email to Jennifer requesting bio/pic of chow/parsons.

Returned call **(R91)** from investigator office Dennis Fildundee? Asst. Chief Investigator.

He wants to meet so I can tell my side of the story, meet with another male? Told him I wasn't sure if he is the correct person to meet with. He said bring down any evidence that I want them to consider. I'm assuming that Lynne wants to know the evidence I have that could implicate her. I don't trust him.

Received reply email from TX AG saying they are not equipped to handle this via email. Gave me the original phone number I called to call again.

Monday: Oct. 15

Called AG **(R92)** left msg.

TXAG returned call **(R93)** Brief request is in progress and should have next week.

They returned the 911 call to HCAO so they can't compare. Also, 45 day release is standard procedure.

The guy seemed a little defensive.

Received Email from Harris County Attorney Office, Leslie Austin for Cheryl Thornton – they do not have my requested data and they are not going to get it. Gave me contact info for sheriff's office (Tebben Lewis) and District Atty office (Zahra Goode, adm Asst). I have to request police report from them. HCSO and the investigators report from HCDA

Sent follow up email to Leslie Austin PIA Group with 2 requests and 1 question. Ask for data to initiate the brief, email address, and asked where the evidence is they sent to the AG?

Sent email to HCSO Tebben Lewis asking for public information – replied
Sent email to HCDA Zahra Goode asking for public information – replied

Monday Oct: 22

Sent request to ACLU for help.

Thursday Oct: 25

Sent email PIA request to HCAO Cheryl Thornton
Sent Email to Jim Leitner requesting help

Monday Oct: 29

Cheryl Thornton (**R94**) (HCAO) called – said she has no data, no brief, nothing about this case. I'm assuming the 911 call is not associated to the case. Sent her the AG ruling and the brief. She said they sent out a letter yesterday. She did mention the 'requesting agency' when discussing policy

Called Jim Leitner (**R95**) – who was replaced Friday Oct 19th by Bill Hawkins. Talked to Brandy, she pulled up my email, going to print it out and I should hear something in a day or two. This could be the final perfect Karma piece. Someone new with integrity, authority, impartial, independent. Is he an outsider.

Called HCDA Zahra Goode (**R96**), boss out of office will call back. No knowledge of independent investigators.

Tuesday Oct: 30

Call HCDA Zahra Goode (**R97**) status, bosses name? Scott Durfee, he is going file for a ruling with the AG to prevent release of the case data. Bases upon sec 108? I'll receive a copy.

Call HCSO Tebben Lewis (**R98**) status, who do I contact at legal? It appears Anne Ragsdale is the legal dept.

Called HCSO Anne Ragsdale (**R99**) (713-755-5668) She mentioned she was behind 6-8 weeks but they got her some help, maybe colluded with Sgt Thomas to prevent the original release? She sent something to Sgt. Thomas for his approval to release the file. **This doesn't make sense.**

Email to HCAO Cheryl Thornton did you find the brief it under the rug? Where was it filed and why? She replied and said she will look into it, and to give her some time.

Thursday Nov: 1

Email to Bill Hawkins asking for help, plus a forward of Jim Leitner's email with InTake communications

attached.

Friday Nov: 2

Called HCSO Anne Ragsdale (**R100**) for current status. She still hasn't heard from Sgt Thomas. I told her this is a public information request and I don't think Sgt. Thomas has anything to do with it. She is following her procedure. I asked for her supervisor Roel Garcia, left msg for him to call.

Called HCDA Bill Hawkins (**R101**), talked to Brandy, she'll remind him.

Called HCSO Roel Garcia (**R102**) - 713-755-4511, left message, explained situation, asked for a return call.

Tuesday Nov: 6

Call HCDA Bill Hawkins (**R103**), Brandy, 713-755-5814 (713) 755-5930, Brandy did talk to Mr. Hawkins and he is drafting an email, she will confirm and call back.

HCSO Roel Garcia (**R104**) - 713-755-4511, left message asked for a return call.

HCSO Roel Garcia (**R105**) – Returned call he talked to Anne, still no word from Sgt. Thomas, she'll call him all day and they will get back to me. Told him I wanted the police report with all updates, and the investigators report along with a description of all evidence provided to the HCDA.

He asked if charges were brought I said no, he said good then there won't be any problem with that. Sent Email to TXAG – reply to Mr. Durfee brief. Don't need whole file, file related to this case, a few questions for the AG.

Received blank email from Cheryl Thornton secretary Cheryl with letter attached ignoring my request and replying to something not asked for. This is a CYA letter Ms. Thornton is attempting rewrite history by not addressing that she knew nothing about any brief or any other activity HCAO had in this case.

Called TXAG need information on what is and is not covered under public records. There is a cover-up that I need data to expose.

TXAG (**R106**) returned call, I can ask for anything, whether I get it is another story.

*Need to send anything related to the brief via USPS.

Called HCAO Cheryl Thornton (**R107**) cross swords, Vague on why the brief was initiated in the first place, she said there is no conspiracy. She said it was policy to block all 911 calls by default. I asked where I can read that policy and she said the public records act. She is evasive I do not believe HCAO policy states any request for 911 initiates a brief to the TXAG to withhold the call.

Recv reply from Ann – busy, death(S)? in fam, talk to Thomas, but she found data in an unknown area of ARS.

Friday Dec: 14

Reply from Ann-TY.

Called Deputy Luce 979-574-4535 he answered, told him I had a few questions. He said everything is in the report and he has nothing else to say and talk to the investigator. I said that's the problem everything isn't in the report. Told me to have a good day and hung up.

I called back (**R117**) left message – hanging up is not the solution to the problem. I want answers.

Sent update letter 'TXAG-HCDA-BriefReply2.docx' to TXAG Open Records letting them know what I have received from HCSO and asking for the following 4 items because HCSO was unable to find it until I specified these documents – assuming these items were never sent to HCDA from HCSO.

1. The written testimony from Bill Kenny that HCSO provided to HCDA.
2. The oral testimony from Bill Kenny that HCSO provided to HCDA.
3. The 911 call that HCSO supplied to HCDA.
4. The additional 3 pictures Bill Kenny supplied to HCSO Sgt. Weinel 5/15/12 via email.

Tuesday Dec: 18

Fax to 512-481-1992 public records complaint asking for assistance with HCAO to release the document (work order) that initiated the time killing brief to block the 911 call.

Thursday Dec: 20

Sent copy of update letter from the 17th to HCDA. Received email reply from Zahra Goode.

Monday Dec: 24, 2012

Recv letter from TXAG OR in reference to the update letter I sent on the 17th. They received it and will have a ruling on Jan 15th.
